Course Aim:

This course is designed to give basic training and instruction for candidates working with Aluminium Access Towers.

Course Content will include:

- The Law – Regulations & Legislation (including: Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 & The Work at Height Regulations 2005)
- Components of the tower
- Equipment and tools required
- Risk Assessment
- Site conditions / site inspection (including proximity hazards)
- Personal Protective Equipment
- Correct erecting and dismantling / moving procedures
- Maintenance, care and storage

The course is a mixture of theory and practical training / exercises.

On successful completion of this course, candidates will have sufficient knowledge and practical skills to enable them to erect, alter and dismantle Aluminium Access Towers safely in accordance with current health & safety legislation and manufacturers guidelines.
