Fire Warden

Suitable For:

Personnel with designated roles and responsibilities in relation to workplace fire safety.

Course Aim:

This course is designed to assist your company in having a proactive approach to fire safety by training selected staff to be able to perform the role of fire warden/marshal within your workplace.
